

**Irish Bouncing Castles - Terms and Conditions of Hire**

Safety Instruction Sheet when inflatable play equipment is delivered. It is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure that all possible steps are taken to avoid injury or damage to the inflatable. Please ensure that the following safety instructions are followed.

1. The unit has an age limit of 12 years. Please ensure that no one over this age uses the equipment. Under no circumstances should adults use the inflatable.
2. No food, drink or chewing gum are to be consumed on the inflatable. (To avoid choking and mess). A cleaning charge of €50 will be applied if the inflatable is collected in a dirty condition.
3. All shoes, badges and jewellery (large ear rings, necklaces etc) must be removed. It is recommended that spectacles also be removed.
4. No face paints, party poppers, silly string to be used near or on the inflatable as they make a terrible mess and stain the unit which the hirer is responsible for.
5. No smoking near the inflatable.
6. Climbing, hanging or sitting on the inflatable walls is dangerous and must not be allowed.
7. A responsible adult must supervise the inflatable at all times. Warning: never leave unit running unattended. Do not allow children to operate unit.
8. Ensure the inflatable is not over crowded and limit the numbers depending on age and size of children using it. Avoid large and small children using it at the same time.
9. Children are not to push, collide, fight or behave in a manner likely to injury or cause distress to others.
10. Pets, toys, shoes or sharp instruments are not allowed on or near the inflatable at anytime.
11. If the inflatable is not being used for any part of the day, please switch the blower off at the mains.
12. Do not allow anyone to bounce on the step/front apron. The step is there to help users get on and off.
13. Ensure that no one with a history of back or neck problems is allowed on the inflatable.
14. Do not allow users to be on the inflatable during inflation or deflation.
15. In the event of heavy rain, it is strongly recommended that the inflatable be switched off. Any wetness including bubbling can be dried with a towel. A small picnic table placed over the blower will help prevent rain water being sucked into the blower. Ensure that the vent on the side of the blower is kept clear at all times.
16. Do not move the unit from where it has been set up. Do not use the unit near any swimming pools.
17. Ensure that an area of 5 feet (2 metres) around the unit is completely clear.
18. The inflatable should not be used if it becomes wet on the jumping area.
19. In high winds please remove children and switch off power to the inflatable.
20. In the event that the blower stops working, please ensure that all users get off the inflatable immediately.
21. If you are unsure about anything in relation to the inflatable, please contact us.
